### Foundation Stage Newsletter Spring Term 2023









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Dear Parents and Carers.

Welcome back to all our families after the Christmas break. We hope you have all had an enjoyable time with family and friends and are pleased to see all the children's enthusiasm for the new term. All the Early Years staff in both Nursery and Reception would like to say a big thank you for your kind Christmas wishes and gifts; they are very much appreciated!

#### **Topics and Themes**

Across Early Years we will follow the children's interests and plan themes and activities around these. Seasonal topics will include Chinese New Year, Easter and changes in weather, with the children developing their knowledge through stories and enhancements within their play.

Ladybirds will also see a focus on people who help us, number recognition and ordering time using words, such as now/next/then. There will also be lots of opportunities, through play, to experience rhythm and rhyme as well as during regular phonics group sessions.

Red Robins and Little Tigers will explore the local area through maps and aerial photographs, and the local history will be discussed using the children's scrap books, local photographs and stories. They will also develop confidence to recall number bonds of different amounts and shape will be explored to develop awareness of space and how shapes can change or be combined to make new shapes.

#### Winter wear

Please be reminded that all children need to have a pair of named wellies that remain at school. The outside area is accessed in all weathers and children need to be appropriately dressed for the conditions.

Our garden is extremely muddy due to all the wet weather, so children are welcome to bring in named waterproof trousers or all in one suits.

It is a good idea to make sure that all gloves, scarves and hats are labelled

Attaching gloves to string which runs through the arms of your child's coat prevents them getting lost or misplaced!

Reception, please continue to come in wearing PE kit on a Thursday.

Ladybirds do not need PE kit.

The Little Tigers and Red Robins will continue to borrow library books to share at home and further enhance the children's love of reading. Please ensure they are returned each Tuesday so a new book can be selected.

Please continue to add observations of what you have been doing at home so we can enjoy sharing them in school.
