A busy week in Year 4 Cloud cover investigation

"At the start of term we were contacted by a company who work with Cambridge Science Centre, called FAAM. They asked us to complete a week-long cloud investigation to find out more about the cloud coverage in Royston, to know whether it was a good place to use solar panels or not and also whether their predictions of cloud coverage were accurate. Every day at 10am and 2pm we had to go outside and use a thermometer to measure the cloud temperature. We then had to take a photo of the sky from the same position and identify what fraction of the pictured sky was covered in cloud. We had to record whether there were any shadows outside and how long they were as well as the type of cloud we could spot. We have now sent off our data to FAAM and we are looking forward to hearing from them in the coming weeks!"

On Monday, Year 4 enjoyed a walk to the Heath where they gathered data about the plants and animals living there.


