On Tuesday, Year 4 were pleased to be visited by four councillors who had a range of roles from working for the town, the local authority, and the county. The councillors came to ask us about Royston; what we like about it and what we want to be better about where we live. It was a good chance to reflect on the great things about our town but also to give the councillors ideas about what could be improved. They reminded us that having a voice is important and that by suggesting things to them and gaining support for ideas, change can occur. For example, people suggested that the heath should be lit in the dark so floodlights were provided, and the leisure centre was opened after consultations with the public.

We thought hard about what would be something that the council could work on and gave suggestions around:

- more bins for litter and cigarettes
- better park facilities for younger children
- more activities or places for teenagers to go so that they do not overcrowd the parks
- increased bicycle paths.

Hopefully these ideas will be taken to the council and they will think about how to make improvements.
