


In App messages


A reminder that we no longer use ParentMail, and ask that you report your child's absence using In App Messaging in Arbor. Here's how to do it:

This survey is for all children and young people aged 6-18 and for parents/carers who can complete the survey on behalf of children aged 0-5. The survey can be completed here:


