The 48 hour rule

As we approach the season of illnesses, please may we remind you that you are required to keep your child at home for at least 48 hours after they have vomited or had diarrhoea, whatever the cause. This is NHS guidance, designed to prevent the spread of stomach bugs. We are grateful for your co-operation in this matter, to try to keep everyone as healthy as possible.

Attendance

While there are times when your child needs to be collected before the end of the school day, we do ask that this is only as a last resort. Where possible, dental appointments should be made after school or during the holidays.

We urge you not to take your child out of school for holidays; these absences are always unauthorised – even when tagged on to the start and end of term - and could result in a fixed penalty notice being issued for non-attendance.
