Nursery	<p align="center"><b>Expressive Art and Design</b></p> <p>Nursery children are provided with opportunities to explore a broad range of materials, using adult involvement to discuss textures and broaden vocabulary. Many of these materials will have multiple purposes, enabling the children to create pictures and models. Mark making skills are developed through daily fine motor activities and with opportunities across the classroom and the garden to draw on both large and small scales. Children explore different methods of painting while learning colours and exploring how new colours can be made.</p>
