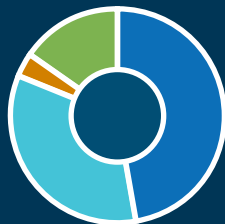

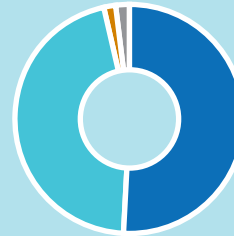

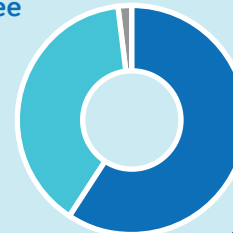

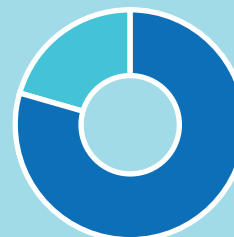
Q: There is a good range of learning opportunities available to my child at this school:
